The Government has a focus on school attendance with a target of 80% of students will have an attendance of 90% or more. Did you know by taking 1 day a fortnight off school your child will lose 20 days of learning - 4 weeks? Attending school regularly, 90% or higher, gives your child the greatest chance of making good progress throughout the year.


